**Project Inauguration:** A project on Livelihood Promotion and Climate Change Adaptation supported by Karl Kubel Stiftung (KKS), Germany, was officially inaugurated on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023, by the Block Development Officer of Jagdalpur Development Block Mr. Gautam Chandra Patil, at Netanar village, in the presence of the Project Director Rev.
